Expert Group Meeting held on 27.09.2018 at Shillong (Meghalaya) under 6th EUS

Point (i) Name and affiliations/designation of the members present at the meeting of the Expert Group on 6th Employment Unemployment (E-U) Survey held on 27.09.2018 at Shillong.


Point (ii) Minutes of meeting of the Expert Group on 6th Employment Unemployment (E-U) Survey held on 27.09.2018 at Shillong.

A meeting of the Expert Group on 6th Employment Unemployment (E-U) Survey was held under the chairmanship of Prof. S.P. Mukherjee on 27.09.2018 at Shillong to finalize the results of 6th E-U Survey conducted by Labour Bureau during August, 2016 to March, 2017.

At the outset, Shri Sunil Chaudhry, Dy. DG welcomed the Chairman and the members of the Group and summarized the discussion held on 13.09.2018 at Chandigarh regarding 6th EUS Report. He informed the Group that the draft report has been prepared on the lines suggested by the Expert Group. DD(GB) made a detailed presentation before the Expert Group. The results were circulated among the Group Members in the meeting for taking the final decision in the matter and the floor was thrown open for discussion.


The Expert Group approved the 6th EUS report with minor additions/deletions as under:

1. The Chairman appreciated the efforts put in by Labour Bureau in preparation of report and stated that the 6th EUS report is much better than those for previous rounds.
2. The Expert Group approved the results revealed by the Survey and recommended that Labour Bureau may send the Executive Summary, after incorporating minor changes as suggested by EG, to MOL&E for perusal/ approval of the competent authority. The Ministry was to be requested for release of the report in public domain, on approved.
3. The Expert Group desired to include some more computations for better presentation of tables. In the process, some of the tables will get excluded while some new tables may find place in report.
4. In view of the fact that only few cases of transgender respondents were come across , it was decided to remove tables that were exclusively for the transgender category.
5. As results from 2nd to 6th rounds of EUS are shown in report for comparison purpose, it was desired that the fact that the first round of EUS had a very limited coverage must be duly mentioned in the report.
6. The age group '15-29' years was decided to be bifurcated as '15-17' and '18-29' years.
7. Analysis of employment situation among respondents in various educational qualification groups showed that unemployment was more with people having Graduate level or higher education whereas the unemployment level was quite low in case of people with no or little education. This may be primarily because higher the education level, more choosy the people are about jobs. It was decided to highlight this choice-based acceptability of jobs in the report.
8. It was decided that the sub-group 'overall' would suffice in Tables showing main activity status and educational qualification and to delete blocks for social group like SC, ST, OBC, and Others.
9. Tables showing Employment Rate for rural and urban areas should include figures data for previous rounds for comparison.


